5. UPDATES FROM LAST MEETING AND IWC PLANNING DECISIONS:

Approvals.

**P/00528/17: Gloucester Cottage, Norton Green, Freshwater:** Proposed two storey dwelling to include formation of vehicular access.

6. PLANNING APPLICATIONS TO BE DISCUSSED (at time of sending out Notice):

P/00682/17: Land between and rear of May Cottage and West Wind, Bay Road,

**Freshwater:** Variation on condition 2 on P/01215/12-TCP/13719/G to allow variation of design plot 1.

It was unclear what the proposed variation was.

**P/00749/17:** Natwest Bank, Avenue Road, Freshwater: Demolition of former bank; construction of new buildings to create shop, flat and two town house.

It was resolved to object on the following grounds:

- 1. The site was too small for the number of units proposed and the Council should object on the basis of layout and density.
- 2. It appeared that the proposed parking would mean vehicles having to reverse into or out of the space which would present a potential traffic hazard.
- 3. The drainage and flooding problems in Tennyson Road and Avenue Road should be taken into consideration.
- 4. Tennyson Road was already overused for parking.
- 5. The proposal also conflicted with the draft Freshwater Neighbourhood Plan.
