P/00091/18 Cringleford, Bay Road, Freshwater: Demolition of existing rear porch; proposed single storey extension to provide additional accommodation.
6. **PLANNING APPLICATIONS TO BE DISCUSSED (AT TIME OF SENDING OUT NOTICE):**
P/00352/18: Glengower, Bay Road, Freshwater, Isle of Wight, PO40 9QS
Proposed demolition of side extension; proposed new side extension.
It was felt that the elevation plan was inadequate. However the Committee had no objection to the proposal.

P/00366/18: Compton Chine car park off, Military Road, Brook, Newport, Isle of Wight.
Proposed non-illuminated welcome and orientation sign.
The Committee had no objection.
7. **CONSIDERATION OF MODIFICATIONS TO THE PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER AT FRESHWATER BAY.**

The revised scheme was noted and welcomed.

Cllr Nicholson suggested option 1 for Afton Road. However he felt that lines should extend to Pines Trees. This was agreed.

There was discussion regarding a sign to the National Trust car park at Freshwater Bay but it was felt that this should not be pursued.

8. UPDATES

Cllr Nicholson gave an update on the reseeded work at Freshwater Bay. The Freshwater Independent Lifeboat had agreed to their tap being used for watering.

Cllr Bamford confirmed that a new notice board was being ordered for the Library.

Cllr James reported that West Wight Arts had asked to use the notice board at Moa Place.

Cllr Cameron said that the Isle of Wight Council were taking action re fly tipping at Golden Hill.

Cllr James had been in touch with Southern Water re flooding in Longhalves. This was now being monitored.

Cllr Bray reported that she had received an initial report re Stroud Coppice.

Cllr Kennett said that she and Cllr Bamford had attended the Freshwater Bay Residents Association meeting. They had been supportive of plans for the Library.

Cllr Bamford mentioned scaffolding being erected at the Memorial Hall and tarmacking of the car park.

Cllr James confirmed that a new CCTV system was being installed at the Memorial Hall.
